Friends took them shopping for clothes. Strangers left gifts at their door. A group of children collected \$500 to buy bicycles for the Ramirez children.

Because of the help from friends and neighbors, the Ramirez family was able to rebuild their lives. Two months after the fire, Luisa mailed out holiday cards with this message: "Home is more than a building". "Home is wherever this is love.
