Health Awareness

Drinking alcohol during pregnancy can cause damage to your unborn baby. These unborn babies may suffer from fetal alcohol syndrome. Ask your doctor about fetal alcohol syndrome. Be kind to your baby. Don't drink if you are pregnant.

Smoking is one of the most damaging things we can do to our bodies. The long-term damage includes: 75% of all lung cancer deaths, 30% of all cancer deaths, and increased death rates from heart disease and respiratory system diseases. Smoking also causes circulation problems. There are many free programs to help people quit smoking. Find them. Use them. Free yourself from a dirty and dangerous habit. Quit now!

Be careful! There are all kinds of medical professionals you can go to for health problems. Doctors with MD after their names are medical doctors. They can write prescription and give you all forms of medications, but there are other doctors who practice alternative medicine". Many of them are legitimate and can help you with some problems. Chiropractors, for example, are licensed and might be able to help you more than a medical doctor for some problems. Acupuncturists too are licensed and might be able to help you with pain or other problems.

Psychologists aren't medical doctors, but they are PhDs and might call themselves doctors, they are not medical doctors. They might be able to help you with family or other problems but they cannot prescribe medications. If you need medications for a psychological problem you should see a psychiatrist. Psychiatrists are medical doctors.

All health professionals should have a license from the state where you live. If you aren't sure, ask to see their license. If you meet a health professional without a license, be careful! He or she hurts more than helps you. Or you might just give away your money for nothing.
